Vision

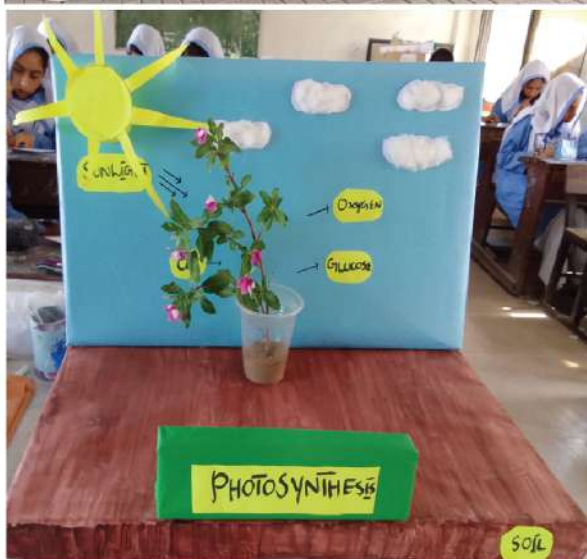
